As a librarian in remote Australia who runs an annual event that attracts guest speakers from across Australia the biggest challenge we have is reaching wider audiences. Our event can't afford the kind of advertising that could reach past our current fans, nor can we afford the kinds of recording technology or staff that could stream our event to people that can't be here in person.

It would be amazing if there were provisions for funding or centralised supports for temp staffing and equipment for regional and remote arts and culture experiences, events and programs that organisations like mine could tap into.

It would also be helpful if cultural policy could feed into tourism in terms of reducing or subsidising the cost of travel to regional and remote places to experience arts and culture.
